All other items of uniform may be purchased from any stockist with the exception of the school tie and PE polo shirts, which are available from Sportcrest, High Wycombe.</p> <p>Water bottles for use during the school day can be purchased from the school office.</p> <p>EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES</p> <p>We aim to provide a stimulating and enriching environment, and this includes extra curricular activities.
