## Pupil absence during term time - reminder

In line with the Department of Education (Pupil Registration (England) Regulations 2006) **'holiday'** and **'extended leave'** should be removed from all paperwork and replaced with **'leave of absence'**. Headteachers are unable to authorise absence during term time unless they are satisfied that there are 'exceptional circumstances'; the fundamental principles for defining 'exceptional' are rare, unavoidable and short, by 'unavoidable' it implies that an 'event' could not reasonably be scheduled at another time. Ideally parents/carers should request 'leave of absence' 4 weeks prior to the leave being taken, it will then be determined by the Headteacher whether or not it is *authorised leave of absence* or *unauthorised leave of absence*.

### Lighthouse Needs You!

For those who are not aware, Lighthouse is a Christian holiday club for primary school age children run by volunteers. The club runs every year in the second week of the summer holidays on the school field at Holy Trinity School, Marlow and this year the dates are Monday 1 to Friday 5 August 2022.
