<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Writing skills based on core text: <b>Romulus and Remus, Roman legends.</b> Creating myths and legend stories.</p> <p>I am a Roman Soldier Writing a poem in the style of <b>Josiah Wedgewood.</b></p> <p>Grammar: Paragraphs, apostrophes, direct and reported speech, adverbials and conjunctions.</p> <p>Biographies-Non-fiction: Features, writing a biography about a Roman God or Goddess.</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>Within the theme 'The Domestic Church' the children will be exploring the topic of <b>People:</b> Jesus' family, family of God, family ties and significant people in the Bible.</p> <p>Judaism</p> <p>During Judaism fortnight the children will be exploring the importance of the <b>Torah.</b></p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>The children will develop an understanding of <b>electricity</b> and the different sources of electricity.</p> <p>They will explore how we use electricity in our daily lives.</p> <p>The children will learn how to classify materials as conductors or insulators and Identify the different parts of an electrical circuit.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Understanding place value and rounding; mental addition and subtraction; multiplication up to 12 x 12; division. Solving problems using addition and subtraction within real life contexts.</p> <p>Converting units of measure. Solving problems with multiplication and division.</p> <p>The children will also be quizzed on their times tables daily.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> <p>The children will learn about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.</p> <p>How was life different then?</p> <p>Where is Rome? How and why did the Empire spread? We will explore: invasions. The children will learn about different computer systems and how they help us perform everyday tasks.</p>
<p><b>Stem</b></p> <p>STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. STEM education is a cross-discipline approach to teaching these interrelated subjects, with problem solving at its heart. Lessons develop critical thinking, teamwork, confidence and creativity.</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>The theme of this topic is Understanding ABBA's music. The children will be looking at songs with the instrumental melody; GABC.</p>		<p><b>DT</b></p> <p>Making a slingshot car. Understanding the chassis and launch mechanism.</p>
<p><b>PE</b></p> <p><b>Gymnastics 1</b></p> <p>Performing a six-part sequence. Exploring core strength and using apparatus to enhance movement.</p> <p><b>Football</b></p> <p>Developing tackling, dribbling and passing skills.
