<p>English We will be starting a new English programme -The Literacy Tree. The core texts provide the children with great opportunities for extended writing and implementing grammar skills within each text.</p> <p>Our core text is Cinnamon, and we will be focusing on diary entries, informal letters, adverts, limericks and dialogue.</p> <p>Grammar focus: inverted commas, prepositions, relative clauses and a range of conjunctions.</p>	<p>RE Local Church Community</p> <p>The children will explore the importance of belonging to the church community. They will learn about and how the parish community support and comfort one another during times of celebration and difficulty.</p>	<p>Science The children will be exploring sound this half term. They will identify how sounds are made, that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear, find patterns between pitch and volume and explore how sounds get fainter as the distance increases.</p>	<p>Maths Part 2 of multiplication and division-solving problems using times tables and division facts with growing confidence. Both year groups will study Length and perimeter. However, year 4 will study Length and perimeter of rectilinear shapes too.</p> <p>Year 4 Fractions and decimals- ordering fractions, comparing fractions, converting mixed numbers and improper fractions, equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions</p> <p>Year 3 Fractions- understanding the numerator and denominator, unit fractions, ordering fractions, fractions on a number line, fractions as bar models.</p>
<p>History The children will learn about the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons.
