Cinderella of the Nile Re-told by award-winning and influential children's author Beverley Naidoo, this version of Cinderella supports learning around traditional tales. The children will be writing newspaper reports, diary entries, character descriptions, adverts and their own versions of this classic tale. In addition, they will be focusing on conjunctions, expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and different tenses.	RE Lent/Easter: Self-Discipline  We will explore the love and care shown in the family and how Lent is an opportunity for spiritual growth. All lessons will be remembering and celebrating the death and resurrection of Christ.	Science Rocks The children will learn about rock formation, properties and permeability. In addition, they will learn about soil and fossils and conduct investigations to compare and categorise rocks, soils and fossils. We will be visiting the Oxford Museum in Oxford to extend the children's learning for this topic.	Maths Year 4 Fractions and decimals- ordering fractions, comparing fractions, converting mixed numbers and improper fractions, equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions,. Tenths and hundredths.  Year 3 Fractions A- understanding the numerator and denominator, unit fractions, ordering fractions, fractions on a number line, fractions as bar models. Mass and capacity- using scales, grams and kilograms, equivalent capacities and volume.
Geography Hills and mountains Throughout this unit, the children will learn about mountain ranges in the Uk and other parts of the world such as North and South America. They will learn how mountains are formed and how to describe them based on their key properties.
